ML) Who is David Saint-Jacques?

David Saint-J was born on January 6th, 1970. He is 56 years old now. David is a Canadian astronaut that worked for the CSA, he was a doctor and a Co-Chief of medicine in Nunavik. He was born in Quebec City, and he grew up in Saint Lambert which is a small residential city on the south shore of saint-Lawrence River. He worked in biomedical engineering at the Labossiere hospital in Paris. David was a part of the team improving and the design of radiological equipment for Cine-angiography he is also the Canadian astronaut that had the longest mission of a total 204 days, 15 hours and 13 minutes.

Why did David Saint-Jacques go to space? David went to space because NASA sent him for a scientific research and for a space walk.

Where was he educated? David studied at the University of Montreal, in 1993 he earned a bachelor's degree in engineering physics from Polytechnic in Montreal and he started working with the other astrophysicists. In 2001 he returned to Canada, in 1998 he earned a PhD in astrophysics at the Cambridge University in the U.K. In 2007 David completed his residency at the Cambridge McGill University in Montreal.

In what missions did David participate? David S-J participated in four missions, his missions were called Expedition 57, Expedition 58, Expedition 59 and Expedition Soyuz MS-11.

What was David's favourite and least favourite part of going to space? His favourite part of going to space was the morning routine. He also liked observing the earth and watching the thin blue line of earth's atmosphere. His least favourite part of going to space was the journey back, he described as very hard to manage. David didn't like that he had to be away from his family for so long, other thing he didn't liked was the artificial and the isolated daily life aboard the ISS.

Where did David S-J go to space? David Saint-J went to the ISS for the 204 days of his mission

Fun facts: He was an astrophysicist in U.K., Tokio Japan, Hawaii U.S. and Montreal Canada. He was chosen for the Canadian Space Agency, and he became an astronaut in 2009, he is an Engineer, an astrophysicist, a medical doctor and he contributed to advances in telescope technology, David Saint Jacques has Two sons and one daughter, and his wife's name is Veronique Morin, He also likes cycling, mountaineering, skiing, and landscapes
