Who owns the Regina Pats?

The current owner of the Pats is the Brandt Group of Companies. Brandt has been the owner since March 12, 2021.

Where did the Pats originate from?

The Regina Pats originated in Regina, Saskatchewan. The Regina Pats have been in Regina since 1917. They were originally named the Patricia Hockey Club. They got their name from a Princess named Patricia. Princess Patricia is the granddaughter of Queen Victoria, and the daughter of the Governor General of Canada. She was the honorary leader of a special army group in 1918.

When did the Pats start?

The Pats first game was on Thursday, Oct. 30th. They are the oldest major junior hockey league franchise in the world. In 1917, they only played exhibition games. But in 1966 to 1967 they played in the SJHL. They finally joined the WHL in 1971 and they won in 1974 and 1980.

What have the Regina Pats accomplished?

The Pats have won two championships in 1974 and 1980. They also won four memorial cups in 1925, 1928, 1930, and 1974. The Regina Pats accomplished insane comebacks and good prospects like Maddox Shultz. Maddox Shultz is one of the top prospects for the NHL 2028 draft.

How do the Regina Pats affect the NHL?

They have sent over one hundred prospects, to be exact 167 prospects. A prospect is a young player who could have a potential NHL career. Most common players are Connor Bedard

and Chandler Stephenson. The Pats have sent the 2nd most prospects to the NHL.

New Uniforms for 2026

These new uniforms are meant to reflect a new direction. The Pat's jerseys have the same colors, but with an icy texture to make it pop out more. The blue is now going to be a darker blue. The first time they wore it was against Brandon, on a Friday night.

The Standings and Roster
