Big bud is related to Big Brute because it is specifically designed to look like a series 3 big bud tractor.

The Big Bud engine is a 16-cylinder, Detroit diesel. Originally, Big Bud measured 27 feet long, 20 feet wide, and 14 feet tall. When the 1000-gallon fuel tank is full, the tractor tips the scales at over 100000 POUNDS(50 tons)! The tractor was designed for the Rossi Brothers, cotton farmers in Bakersfield, California. The Rossi Brothers used the tractor for deep ripping. They owned and operated the tractor for 11 years. After leaving the cotton farm of the Rossi Brothers the Big Bud found its way to Indlandic, Florida. The second owners, Willowbrook Farms, also used the tractor for deep ripping purposes. Willowbrook Farms retired the big bud and left it to rest. In 1997 the Big Bud found its way back

home to Montana, only 60 miles from where it was built. The Williams Brothers of Big Sandy, Montana purchased the tractor and brought it to their home in Chouteau County. The Williams Brothers use the tractor for cultivation purposes, pulling an 80 foot cultivator. The tractor can work up 1 acre per minute at speeds up to 8mph. Except its new paint job, updated tires and wheels and a whopping 1100,-the Big Bud looks like I when it rolled out The Northern Manufacturing Company back in 1977.
